(Fifth grade)

Use the note names from the scale to fill in the blanks. Notes that have ties (curve between two notes) only have one blank because the tied notes have the same name. (*Note the exception on the words "are" and "there" on the last staff.)

You Are There

Eb Eb Bb Eb F G G F
 Where can I go from Your Spir - it?

 Where can I flee from Your pre - sence?

 You are there

*The curve on the two notes of the word "are" and the first two notes of the word "there" is called a slur. It is different from a tie. The notes joined by a slur do not have the same name.

"You Are There" is in the key of Eb which has three flats - Bb, Eb and Ab. The first four notes given below are to help you fill in the blanks above. The key of Eb begins and ends on a Eb. Can you see where the scale begins and ends?
